

Homework Guidelines

Objectives for giving homework are:

1. To encourage meaningful conversation between parents and children about schoolwork. Research shows that school achievement increases when children talk about things of importance, like their schoolwork, at home.
2. To provide the students with reinforcement and practice at home that is needed to master second grade skills.
3. To teach the students to be responsible for getting materials between home and school
4. To help teach time management and organization

Your child will have some homework every night. This will include an individualized reading homework, sometimes a math sheet (practicing math facts) or a language arts sheet. You will be able to find the the assignments that are due in your child's planner. All homework will be listed and you will need to sign to indicate that you have viewed what needs to be completed. All homework, unless otherwise noted, should be returned the next day.

It is your child's responsibility to neatly complete all homework. If your child has difficulties with his/her homework please print me a note in the planner. THANKS!

Sample of what a homework schedule may look like:
